

# Aurora Public Library District Reopening Safety Precautions

**These safety measure are being observed at the Aurora Public Library, the Dillsboro Public Library, and the Local History Library.**

**Employee Health Screening Process:** All employees are evaluated using the following three questions before starting any work shift:

- Is the employee running a fever?
- Is the employee experiencing a persistent cough not related to allergies or other known health conditions?
- Has the employee been in physical contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19?

**If the answer to any of these questions is yes, the employee will not be allowed to work.**

## **Enhanced Cleaning:**

- Library materials are quarantined for 72 hours when returned to the building.
- High-use surfaces are frequently cleaned.
- Computer equipment is cleaned after each user.

## **Compliance with Social Distancing:**

- Library employees are practicing 6-foot social distancing from each other and from library customers
- Customers are asked to follow social distancing while in the library
- The number of people in each building is monitored to ensure social distancing is possible.
- In-person programming is being postponed.

## **Personal Hygiene:**

- All library employees will wear cloth masks when in the library.
- Library employees will practice frequent hand-washing.
- Hand-sanitizer stations are located in public areas for library customers to use.
