I am currently reading *Canary Girls* by Jennifer Chiaverini which is our January book for Between the Lines (BTL), our long-running monthly book club led by Ron Nicholson, Professor Emeritus and retired SDHS English teacher. This historical fiction book transports you to World War I Great Britain and the women who filled in at factories while the men were away at war. Attendees can join sessions either in the afternoon or evenings, as there are three possible sessions each month.

We also offer Not Your Mother's Book Club (NYMBC) which meets monthly at the Depot and covers books selected by input from attendees; our adult programming staff, Sarah Ankenbauer, leads this group. The January title, *Tricks* by Ellen Hopkins, is a novel in verse describing the lives of five troubled teens.

If you've resolved to read more in 2026, I hope you will join one of our book clubs. The book copies can be found at either Aurora or Dillsboro—and on Libby when available.

We'll provide all the supplies and optional scripts if you need a little inspiration. Drop your letter in our Library Love mailbox, and we'll mail everything out at the end of the month.




