### A Note From Our Director

At long last, spring is arriving—a sense of rebirth arrives along with it. At APLD, we have many arrivals coming in the months ahead—the opening of the completed Dillsboro renovation, the caboose arrival and update at the Local History Library at the Depot, and a summer reading program called “Unearth a Story” (there will be dinosaurs). Libraries are facing budget challenges with the legislative changes in the past two sessions, but APLD is planning ahead so that we may be able to continue valuable resources and programs. One strategic move we are making, effective May 1, is to limit access to the Indiana Digital Library to resident card holders (residents of Center, Clay, Caesar Creek, Hogan, Manchester, and Washington townships in Dearborn County); IDL is available through most Indiana libraries and so most of our non-resident card holders will still be able to access Libby while saving APLD some funds. Another strategy is reviewing our patron needs with our patron survey which will allow us to focus on updated patron needs and wants. Please use your phone camera app to scan this QR code and complete the survey. A link will be on our website by March 1st and there will be paper copies available at the circulation desks. We would like the survey completed by March 31st.

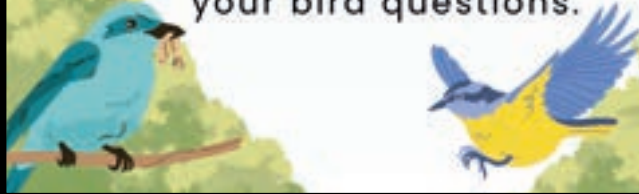

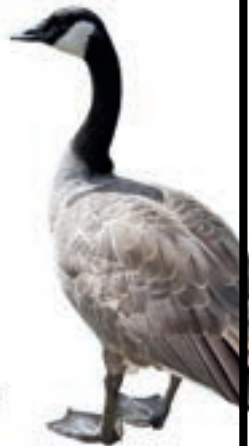
