A Note From Our Director

The Dillsboro Public Library commemorative brick path includes a special brick dedicated in memory of Jana Holtegal by Rhea Dawn Johnston. I appreciate Rhea purchasing this brick so many years ago to help keep the memory of Jana alive. Rhea, Jana, and I were in the same class at Dillsboro School and friends who ran together on the playground and stayed up too late at sleepovers. Unfortunately, Jana experienced a serious health complication during our childhood which profoundly changed her life and caused her subsequent early passing, so the brick serves as a memorial I regularly see. I just read *All the Blues in the Sky* by Renee Watson, which shares the journey of a girl processing grief after losing a long-time friend; some things that bring her comfort are a memorial and a packet of keepsakes gifted her by her friend's family. This story resonated with me, reminding me of Jana's passing and her memorial brick, but coincidentally this summer, I was also given a packet of correspondence in childish handwriting from Retta Thayer Callis, Jana's mother! These letters written by our 11-year-old selves gave me a smile as I read about the "news" that I found important enough to share with Jana. Sometime stories do indeed reflect everyday lives! Dillsboro Ribbon Cutting

The Aurora Public Library District hosted a ribbon cutting ceremony on June 20th at the Dillsboro Public Library to celebrate the completion of their building project. Renovations began on the Dillsboro Library in April of 2025 and include two new private study spaces and two large meeting rooms, a reading room with a cozy fireplace, an outdoor seating and play area, a bigger children's room, a room specifically for teens, more restrooms, updated display shelving in the Local History Room, and a garage for an incoming bookmobile.

The ceremony included many Dillsboro residents including Jeanne Kinnett singing the National Anthem, Doug Baker and Tim Benning raising the flag, and Hunter and Lincoln Fox assisting with the ribbon cutting. There was a poetry reading by professor emeritus, Ron Nicholson, and Library Board President, Ben Turner, and Library Director, Leslie Sutherlin, both spoke about the renovation process.

Dillsboro Wall of Fame

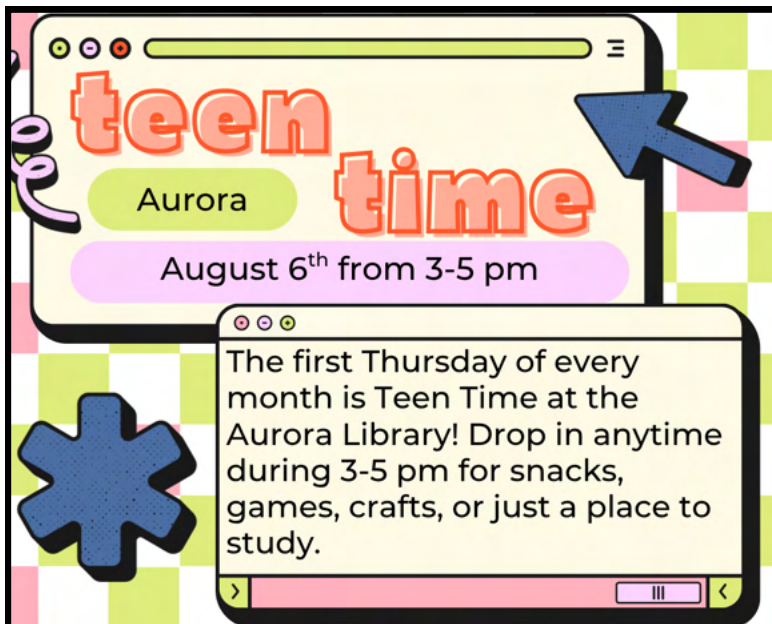
